COURTS

ARTICLE I. IN GENERAL

Sec. 7-1. Cases to be filed before Associate Circuit Judges.

Freeburg municipal ordinance violation cases shall be heard and determined by Associate Circuit Judges as provided by Section 479.040, RSMo 1978.

Sec. 7-2. Repeal of Municipal Court Provisions.

All ordinances that make provision for the Municipal Court of Freeburg, Missouri are repealed.

Sec. 7-3. Notification of Circuit Clerk.

The Village Clerk is directed to forthwith transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the circuit clerk for the circuit court of which the municipal division for Freeburg is a division.

Sec. 7-4. Collection of court costs.

1. The provisions of Sections 590.100 to 590.150 Missouri Revised Statutes 1978 are adopted.
2. The official of the Circuit Court responsible for collecting court costs shall assess as costs, a fee up to two dollars (\$2.00) for each court proceeding filed for violations of the ordinances of the City of Freeburg provided that no such fee shall be collected for non-moving traffic violations, and no such fee shall be collected for violations of fish and game regulations, and no such fee shall be collected in any proceeding in such court when the proceeding or defendant has been dismissed by the court.
3. Such fees collected shall be transmitted monthly to the Treasurer of the City, and will be deposited in the City's general fund.
